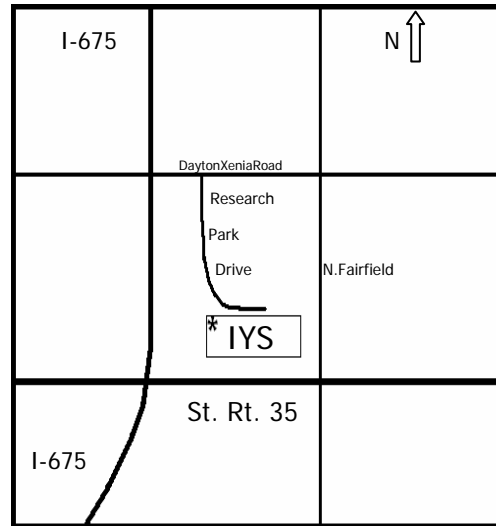
CRISIS INTERVENTION

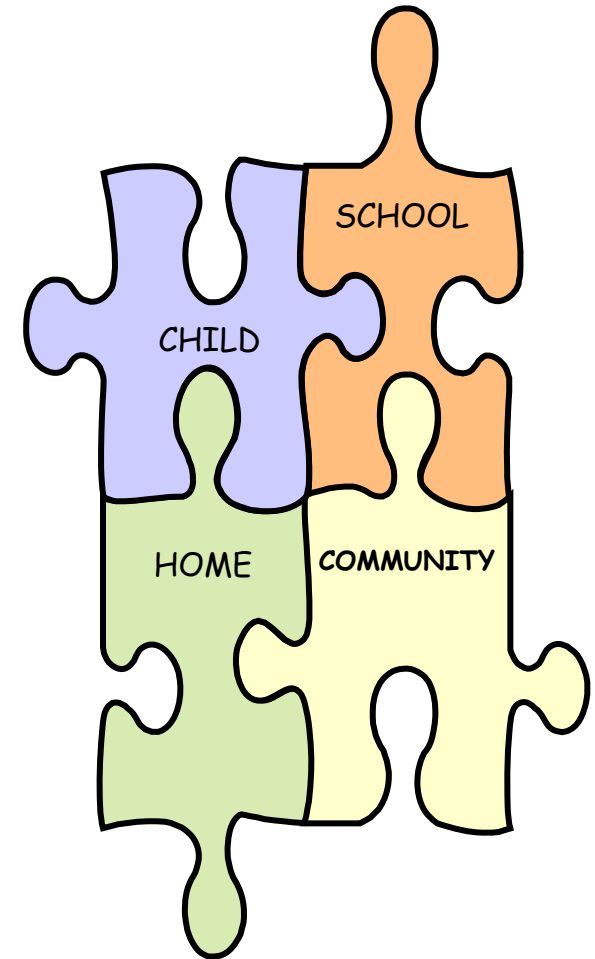
Take St. Rt. 35 to the North Fairfield Road exit.

INTEGRATED YOUTH SERVICES

Integrated Youth Services seeks to improve the quality of life for Greene County youth and families by collaborating with other youth serving agencies to provide and advocate for a continuum of care for culturally-sensitive youth behavioral health services.



DRUG & ALCOHOL SERVICES

IYS offers an adolescent outpatient drug and alcohol program intended for adolescents who have experimented with, are abusing, or dependent on mood-altering chemicals. This program provides diagnostic services, group, individual and family sessions to address life area difficulties experienced due to chemical use.

The goal of this program is to assist adolescents and their families in identifying the ways that chemical use or problem behaviors have affected their lives and to assist them in developing a drug and alcohol free lifestyle.

PROGRAM STRUCTURE

ASSESSMENT

A chemical dependency professional will meet with the youth and their family to determine the extent of chemical use. An individualized treatment program will be developed to address the youth's needs. All information regarding the youth's treatment program will remain confidential.

TREATMENT SERVICES

INDIVIDUAL COUNSELING

Individual sessions are offered for the youth to address their specific needs and problem areas. Each session will be scheduled with a chemical dependency professional. Treatment goals will be addressed and the youth will receive support for change.

FAMILY COUNSELING

Chemical dependency and abuse affects the entire family. Therefore, family sessions will be scheduled to address these issues. Relationship building and establishment of trust will be the focus of these sessions.

GROUP COUNSELING

Group sessions are held with youth peers to address common problem areas and to give/receive support for positive choices and change. Group topics may include

problem solving, effective coping skills, dealing with peer pressure, anger management and positive relationship skills.



INTENSIVE OUTPATIENT PROGRAM

When more structured treatment is indicated, Integrated Youth Service offers an Intensive Outpatient Program. This program consists of three weekly group sessions, individual/family involvement and a commitment of community support meetings.

CASE MANAGEMENT, AFTERCARE & REFERRAL SERVICES

Case Management, Aftercare and referral services are offered to provide continuity of care and linkages to community resources.

CONFIDENTIALITY
